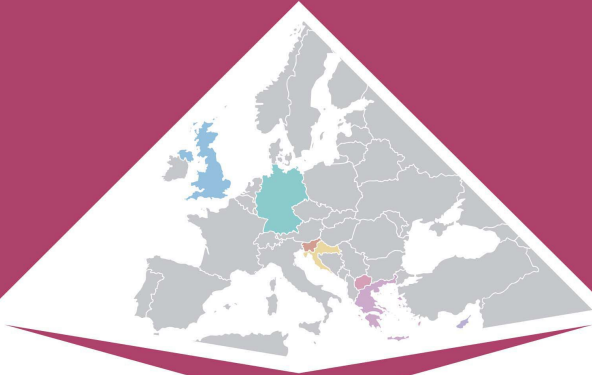




STEPin
