The platform [STEPin e-Academy](#) & [Assessment Tool](#) is in the final stage and is also available on mobile Apps.



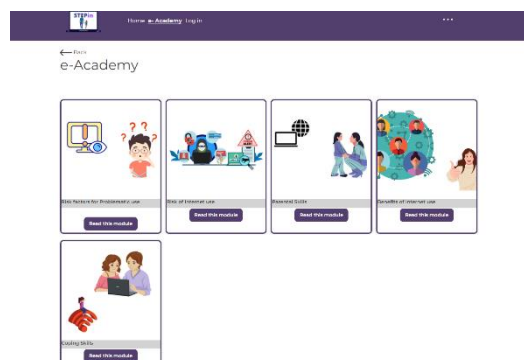
## Closing of the Output 4
